

The FACE Perinatal Toolset V.1

V.1 of the FACE Perinatal Toolset offers a comprehensive documentation system for the routine recording of clinical data and the measurement of outcomes in perinatal mental health services. It is designed to meet the need for robust measures of clinical outcome, patient-reported outcomes and measures of quality and performance such as CQIN, as well as broader national requirements of CPA, and the mental health minimum dataset.

The toolset has been developed collaboratively with East Midlands Specialised Commissioning group, East Midlands Perinatal Clinical Network, and Nottinghamshire and Derbyshire Mental Health Trusts.

The Tools

The tools included are as follows:

- **Background Information** – front sheet including key demographics, alerts, referral details, key contacts and children.
- **Referral Processing** – for managing referrals, recording of next steps and key episode details such as dates and times of initial contact, admission and discharge.
- **Perinatal Overview Assessment (Clinical version)** – a comprehensive holistic multi-professional assessment for perinatal services, including full personal and social history and a detailed assessment of clinical and social functioning tailored to the perinatal context. The tool meets the requirements of CPA and supports generation of HoNOS scores and PbR clusters. The tool includes embedded scales to enable outcome measurement to be integrated within routine practice.



- **Perinatal Overview Assessment OMDS** – this ‘Outcomes Minimum Dataset’ version of the Overview Assessment captures in a single document all key data items required to measure and analyse clinical and social outcomes. It is intended for those wishing to measure outcomes but who are unable to or do not wish to adapt their local clinical documentation.
- **Risk Profile** – this perinatal version of the FACE Risk Profile includes recording of dynamic and static risk factors; mother and others’ views on risk; risk management and contingency plans; and clinically-oriented judgments of risk to both mother and infant. The tool also meets the standards described set out in the Dept’ of Health’s ‘Best Practice Guide to Managing Risk’.
- **‘How are you?’** This patient-reported outcome measure (PROM) is an adapted version of the FACE quality of life outcome measure. This new version has been adapted for perinatal services in consultation with East Midlands user groups.
- **‘Your Treatment and Care’** provides a readily auditable measure of the patient’s experience of treatment and care. These new versions – one for in-patient and one for community services - have also been adapted for perinatal services in consultation with East Midlands user groups.

All tools may be used either standalone or in conjunction with the other tools.

Quality and outcomes benchmarking

Facilities are being developed to support both local and national benchmarking. The FACE Health and Well-being Intelligence

Suite is installable locally and provides comprehensive interactive outcomes reporting facilities at both individual and aggregated levels.

Additionally, a central database is planned where data may be submitted anonymously from around the country and which will enable local users to compare their outcomes and patients with those elsewhere.

Integration with local and national IT systems

The tools are supplied with a standard interface supporting implementation on local IT systems. There are plans to integrate the tools with widely used software systems, e.g. RIO. FACE also supplies software supporting standalone data collection and analysis for users wishing to collect outcomes data separately from their main IT system.

Price

The price of the toolset is £750 p.a. for a single team (e.g. MBU or perinatal community service) or £1250 p.a. for a full perinatal service (in-patient and community). Please note that participation in benchmarking and use of FACE software may incur an additional charge.
